Items to discuss and approve at this meeting include: 2019 budget, Council members for 2019, senior pastor job description, safe church policy, and a general listening session to discuss any concerns or comments from the

congregation. Several of these topics are very important for our Search and Call process to move forward in selecting our next pastor. It is important that all of our congregation members understand and have input to these topics, so we are aligned in our expectations as we move forward.
