1 bottle of liquid household cleaner 12 - 16 oz.

(must be water mixable to spray bottles)

1 non aerosol insect repellent, 6 - 9 oz.

clothesline, 1 - 100 ft. or 2 - 50 ft.

1 pair work gloves, cotton with leather palm or all leather

2 pairs non-surgical latex gloves, should be durable for multiple uses

1 - 50 oz. or 2 - 24 oz. liquid laundry detergent (bottles only)

1 liquid disinfectant dish soap, 16 - 28 oz.

18 reusable cleaning wipes (i.e. easy wipes)

7 sponges, including 1 large (=jumbo) sponge

24 - 48 heavy-duty or contractor type trash bags size

30-45 gallon in a roll

1 bucket with lid, 5 -gallon only

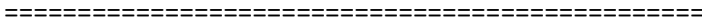
