On March 15 we will hold a special congregational meeting immediately after Church services to discuss hiring Rev. Dr. Judith Scott as our official pastor, on a part-time basis. This does not change our efforts to continue to find a full-time pastor for Central UCC, it merely creates a more formal and settled position both for CUCC and Rev. Scott while we continue to look for a full-time pastor. Please plan to attend this meeting immediately after Church services on March 15.

Rev. Jim Allen will be visiting Central UCC on the weekend of March 27-29, and will conduct our Sunday Services on March 29. The Search and Call Committee and the Council have agreed to bring Rev. Allen in as part of his interview process. Rev. Allen lives in northern Illinois, so rather than making a trip to preach at a neutral pulpit and then possibly come a second time to preach at CUCC, we decided to have him go ahead and conduct our service. Please keep in mind that neither the Search and Call Committee nor the Council have as yet made a recommendation to hire Rev. Allen, we are just considering him for our full-time pastor position. We will have a Meet and Greet Luncheon immediately following the service on March 29 so that everyone will have time to meet Rev. Allen and his wife Carol. Please plan to attend this important service on March 29.

The Women's Fellowship Lenten Quiet Hour will be held Tuesday, March 10, beginning at 12:00 noon. The Women's Fellowship officers and the Elenor Circle will host and provide a light salad luncheon.
